Who arranges adoption Non-agency adoptions If you want to adopt a child who is a close relative or a step-child (for example, the child of your spouse, civil partner or cohabiting partner), you do not need to involve an adoption agency.

What is adoption Who can adopt

If you want to adopt a child, you must normally be at least 21. If you are part of a couple and one of you is the parent of the child who is to be adopted, the parent must be at least 18, and the step-parent, who will be the adopter, must be at least 21. There is no legal upper age limit.

The mother or father must have parental rights and responsibilities in respect of the child and be over 18 years old. As in all adoption cases, the adopter must be aged 21 or over. The adopter and the parent must live in Scotland. The child must be under the age of 18, and unmarried if aged 16-18.
