Comment Framework Progress Reports and Report Cards

Ontario students can use the Student Evaluator self-assessment to determine how well they fulfill the requirements of each Learning Skill. Students can fill out the self-assessment questionnaire to get a sense of each learning skill, and how these learning skills will be assessed on the Ontario Report Card.
